- ArcPad can not now be used for administration purposes...any site with ArcPad has signed an amendment to the current agreement
- Charging for Dongles
- Chest ArcInfo discussion list on JISCMail
- ArcView CDs for students - any Chest site with a site licence (so option 1 – 4) are entitled to Free 1 year ArcView CDs for students
- Overseas Use – form available on CHEST website
- Training – 50 % discount
