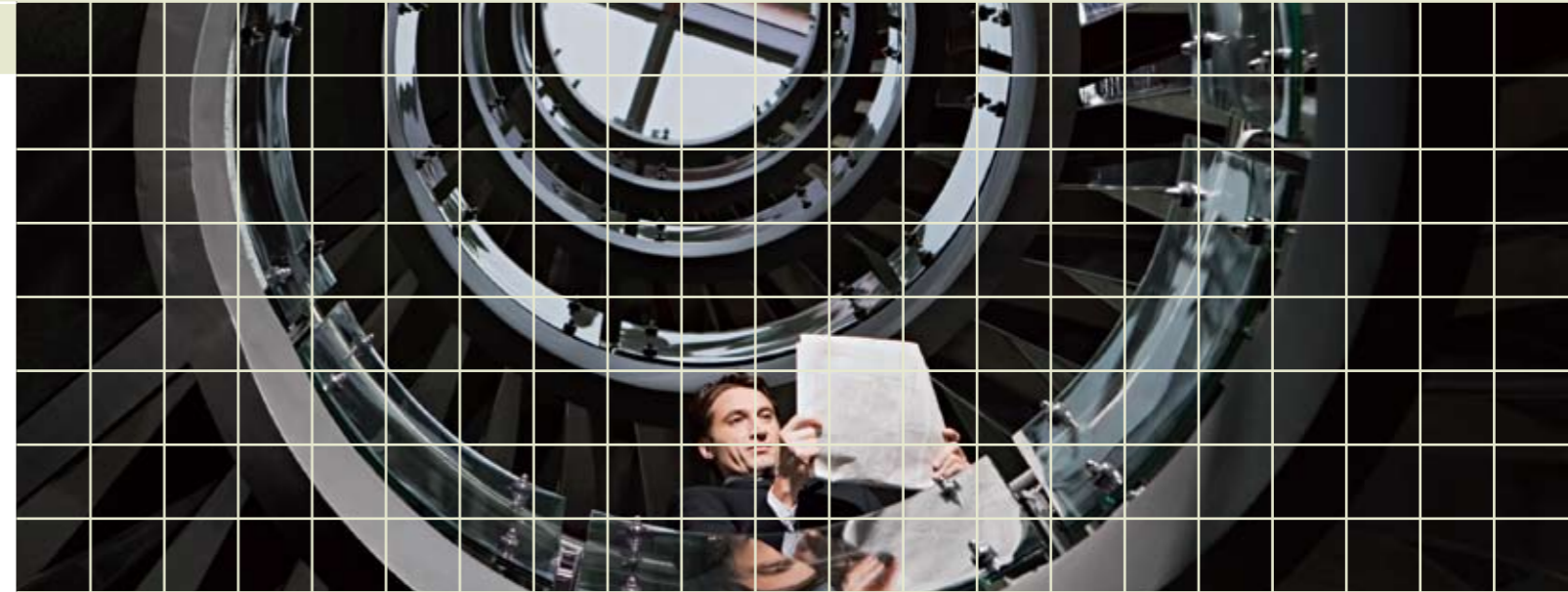

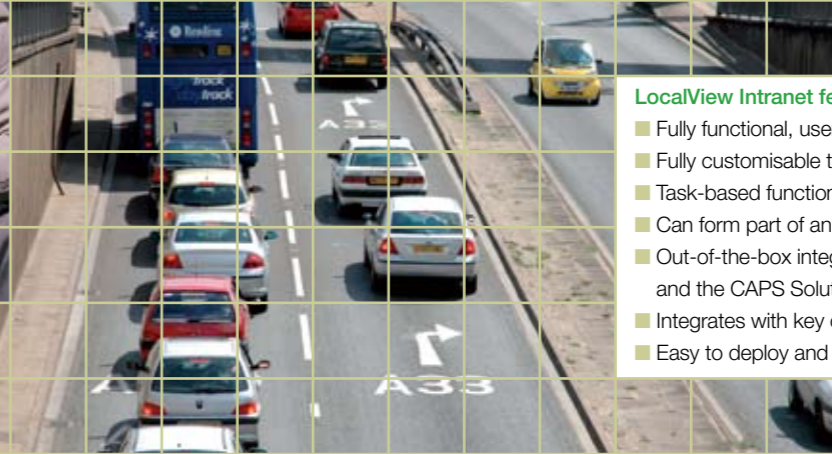

LocalView Intranet enhances the work of individuals and teams across departments by enabling them to access an authority's central repository of spatially-related information – including Ordnance Survey's OS Mastermap® and local authority data, quickly and easily.

The benefits

Encourage knowledge sharing

LocalView integrates data from any council system that holds spatially-related data including CRM, environment, highways, social services, planning, corporate gazetteers and asset management systems. This helps to eliminate siloed stores of departmental data and encourages a culture of knowledge sharing. Moreover, because data is centralised, users can access relevant information collected by other departments and use it in conjunction with their own work.

Improve collaborative working

LocalView Intranet enables council staff to improve collaboration and joined-up working through access to managed and maintained corporate data.

Deliver a holistic view of overall council performance

By integrating geographical information from different systems across the business, Elected Members and Heads of Service can start to visualise and manage the overall performance of council services.

Ensure rapid and cost-effective deployment

LocalView Intranet is accessed via a standard web browser, making it easy and cost-effective to deploy for all users – regardless of their proximity to central offices. Moreover, because it is an off-the-shelf solution designed around the daily tasks council staff need to perform, it requires minimal customisation.

Gain easy access to the Corporate Address Gazetteer

LocalView Intranet incorporates integration with BS 7666 local land and property gazetteers (LLPG) and other back office systems as standard. This strengthens its role as the definitive source of address information for multiple users throughout the authority.

Ordnance Survey

LocalView Intranet can be used in conjunction with the Ordnance Survey's OS Mastermap® data, combining base mapping with council knowledge and data for accurate analysis and service delivery.

Corporate address gazetteer for all

LocalView Intranet ensures that all users with the right privileges can have access to a definitive Local Land and Property Gazetteer (LLPG) strengthening its role as the definitive source of address information.

A complementary solution

LocalView Intranet can be complemented by LocalView Internet: an additional software package designed to enable the rapid and easy deployment of online services for citizens through a local authority website.

What about my existing GIS infrastructure?

As well as being a fully-fledged GIS solution in its own right, LocalView Intranet also integrates with existing standards-based GIS infrastructure for added value and investment protection.

Taking LocalView Intranet to task

LocalView Intranet can be used to carry out a number of typical council tasks. For example, it enables you to:

- Find the nearest facilities to a given point or address
- Search a conservation area for particular attribute or trend
- Overlay and analyse local authority data with map-based information from third parties – for instance, locations of licensed premises from the LLPG, Environmental Health noise complaints and crime data from the Police.
- Integrate service request information from CRM applications or other front line systems to enable Elected Members and Heads of Service to view the performance of front-line services
- Print and 'red line' maps to highlight pertinent information
