

1.3.1. Issues Fixed

Issue #	Description
41356	When editing settings for a Navigator site, if bookmarks are the only thing changed, the Save button is not activated.
37187	ES125986: When editing the provisioning for a Navigator application some of the settings are not restored and have to be re-entered each time. This applies to locking the map extent; navigation show UPRN results and the order of selected layouts for printing.
35855	ES124697: Gazetteer searches do not support locators which return an envelope rather than a point location. When an extent is returned the application should zoom to this extent.
35152	ES124755: The attribute field alias in the identify tool is not pulled through into the "identify results" correctly.
33123	Minor style sheet problem with extra space forcing toolbar to spill into a second row on some screen resolutions.

33274	Printing: Address search pin does not show on print.
34300	Feature layer identify: When identify is performed with feature layers the visibility of the feature layer is not honoured, so it will identify all layers regardless of their visibility.
34484	Identify does not show ArcGIS Online field aliases.

Issue #	Description
	Identify: Missing height parameter when using the identify function. Scale dependant layers will sometimes not return results as identify uses the height and width to work out the current scale.
	Identify: If by default a layer was set to be off in a map service then it would not show up in the identify results; even when the user turned the layer on and it was visible on the map. This was a bug in ArcGIS Server. This bug has been fixed by Esri at ArcGIS Server 10 SP5. It is therefore necessary to upgrade to SP5.

7. Known Issues

7.1. Known Issues and Workarounds

Issue #	Description
44539	Legends for ArcGIS Online feature services are not displaying when there are multiple symbols per layer.
40329	ES128528: Error responses from ArcGIS Server are cached, so that even when the error is resolved the user may continue to see the cached error message. The workaround is to clear the LocalView Fusion cache.
36561	Printing: Gazetteer marker pin obscured in printing when dynamic layers with solid fills displayed on map.
35741	Printing: Printing does not adhere to the scale thresholds and may print content that should be hidden.
32043 & 36002	ES122358/ES125434: long lists (20 items) of bookmarks are not displayed properly in IE8 and IE9. A scrollbar is displayed but it does not function correctly. The only way to move through the list is to using the down key on the keyboard.
31737	Navigator does not display "bing" copyright icon in IE8 and FireFox. Copyright has to be typed in manually.
25973	ES125564: The 'centre map' button in the middle of the navigation buttons on the navigation control doesn't work. If you click it, the map does not get reset to its default location.
31841/9 710	Text labels - May overwrite distance/measurement text on some shapes. If using both annotations it may be best to add the measurement to the label instead or add a point to label.
12060	Selecting multiple graphics - when graphics overlap, more than one graphic may appear to be selected (highlighted in yellow). The reported details (in the popup window) refer to a single selected graphic and use this graphic in subsequent queries. Check that you actually have the intended graphic selected.
31841/8	Tolerance on selecting graphics - particularly polyline graphics.
909	When trying to select a polygon graphic by clicking inside it, sometimes the graphic selected is a (nearby) polyline graphic instead. Similarly when trying to select the buffer polygon around a polyline graphic it sometimes selects the polyline in preference to the polygon. Click again to select the correct graphic.
