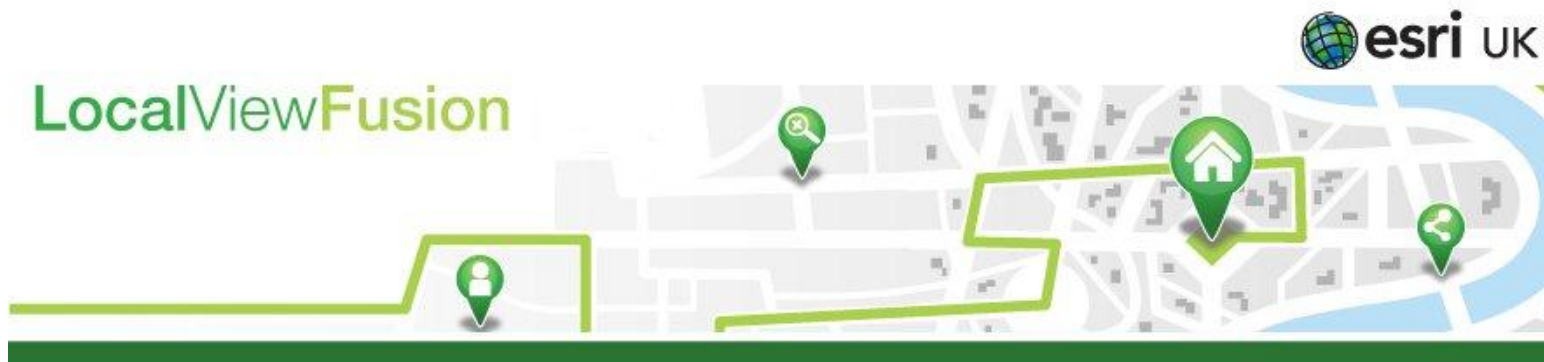

An option has been added in provisioning not to return the geometry on feeds. This allows feeds to run faster if you do not require the map coordinates returned.

33263	Option not to return geometry on feeds. Feeds can now just be listed without returning map coordinates.

Issue #	Description
30193	If the feed was not set to show on the map, an error occurred when closing the feed.
34347	When editing a page link, options were displayed that were not applicable to page links. These have now been removed.
37369	MyLocation template fails when accessed via a reverse proxy.
30194 ES125942	When you set a feed to not show on the map it works fine; but if you then open and close the feed, it shows on the map (Support Reference Number = ES125942).

33135	Feed symbology issues in IE7.
33062	Custom theme text doesn't show correctly in the provisioning colour picker until you click on it.
33022	Address banner doesn't scale in two column mode.
32628	The custom theme default background colour is not set when editing an existing site.

8.2. What is MyLocation

MyLocation is a LocalView Fusion template which provides geographical information to website visitors around their selected property or location. End users can view a single page report of all services and facilities at a specified address or location.

8.3. Features

MyLocation can be configured in a variety of ways to provide information on specific areas, such as local amenities. Generally the information provided will be focused around a particular subject so that it fits thematically within a relevant page on a website, rather than providing all possible data layers in one instance of the application.

The MyLocation template is:

- Embeddable within your website.
- Configurable and can function as a standalone page or fit into an existing page's content.
- Can detect if the user is on a mobile device and display the page in a suitable format for mobiles.

8.4. Browser support

MyLocation is compatible with Internet Explorer versions 7 to 9, Chrome and Firefox.

8.5. Mobile support

MyLocation is not yet formally tested on mobile devices.

8.6. Accessibility

While the MyLocation template has been developed with accessibility as a primary design principle, Esri UK have not yet completed the WCAG 2.0 certification process with this version.

Future releases of MyLocation will be certified to 'AA' level of the WCAG 2.0 guidelines.

9. Known Issues

9.1. Known issues and workarounds

Issue #	Description
39756	MyLocation duplicates location related content and linked content if you search again. If you do Ctrl-F5 or start a completely new search it is fine.
38878	ES127334: Mobile site breaks if there is no map. If you configure a site without a map, go to the mobile version and search for an address, it shows you a blank map page. If there is no map, it should link to a different page.
38851	ES127403: The banner is displayed incorrectly after running a second address search. It either goes blank or repeats the banner image.
35200	When you have a feed that is a multipoint, the geometry won't get added to the map and the image to the left will be incorrect.
30088	In IE7 the feed results do not show symbology in the list.
30082	Feeds not working if nearby search distance is 1000m. Lowering the search distance works fine.
31807	\$\$Shape\$\$ field not filtered out on a tabular data item.
33136	Provisioning layout issues in IE7.
