

Esri Chest Agreement 2020-23 Site licence banding

The 2020-23 Esri Chet Site Licence will provide unlimited users for key products across an institution. As a result of this we have had to adopt a new pricing model and the use of Jisc Bands is the fairest method to determine the cost for each institution.

A significant advantage of this new unlimited site licence is that it provides a complete online teaching and learning platform for GIS which will help institutions deliver a robust GIS solution to all its users both on and off campus.

The sections below explain how you Esri Site Licence level is calculated.

UK

For UK institutions, [Jisc bands](#) will be used to determine the Esri Site Licence size. The 10 Jisc bands will be divided into the 3 Esri site licence sizes as described in the table below:

Table 1 – Esri site licence and Jisc bands

Esri Site License	Jisc Band
Large	1,2
Medium	3, 4, 5a, 5b
Small	6, 7, 8, 9, 10

Ireland

For Irish Institutions, their equivalent Jisc band is calculated by cross mapping their full-time equivalent students to the closest UK institution. For more information, please contact help@chest.ac.uk

Museums

Museums will all be placed on Small site licences

Others

For other institutions that do not have a Jisc band or cross-mappable equivalent, Esri UK and Jisc will determine the Esri Site Licence size on a case by case basis.
